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Dear Parents,

The end of the school year is quickly approaching! It is not appropriate for us to keep medication at school over the summer – this includes inhalers and Epi-pens – so please make arrangements to pick up your child's medication. Many of these medications are expensive, and we are supposed to dispose of any medication that is not picked up by the last day of school. If your child is not enrolled in summer school, please remember to pick up your child's medication.

**All medication left at school will be disposed of as of June 1, 2010.**

During the summer months, the same guidelines for medication administration followed during the regular school year must be adhered to. The child must have a PHYSICIAN/PARENT REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICINE form completed by the physician and signed by the parent for medication administration of Prescription and Non-Prescription Medication.
