February is “National Children's Dental Health Month”

National Children's Dental Health Month is observed to raise awareness about the importance of oral health. Developing good habits at an early age and scheduling regular dental visits helps children get a good start on a lifetime of healthy teeth and gums. Dental health is an important part of overall health. Let's review the basics.

Brushing

- Removes plaque (Plaque causes cavities and contributes to gum disease).
- . Keeps your teeth and mouth clean and bright, your breath fresh.
- . Frequency: Twice a day.



Flossing

- Cleans spaces between teeth that toothbrushes can't reach.
- Flossing helps prevent gum disease.
- Frequency: Daily



Fluorides

- Use fluoride toothpaste.
- Fluoride prevents cavities by strengthening and protecting the tooth enamel.
- Fluoride can be found in toothpastes, community water supplies, over-the-counter mouth rinses, gels and solutions applied by a dentist.



Dentist

- See your dentist regularly.

Remember for a healthy smile, take good care of your teeth and gums by brushing and flossing every day, eating a balanced diet, limiting snacks and visit your dentist regularly.
